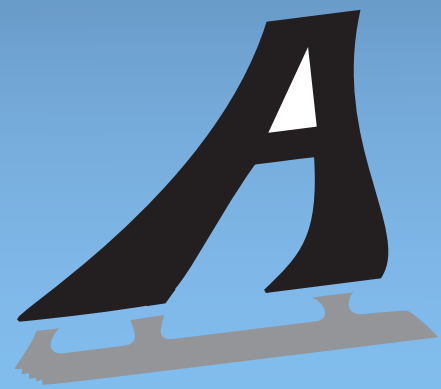
environment with Skate Canada Level 3 coaches. Register now for our next 7 week session starting November 2 to Dec 15. Props and innovative games are used to encourage your child.

Its great to see you all back on the Ice

We would like to remind you of some important safety/etiquette rules:

- ❖ Jumps in the corners
 - ❖ Spins in the centre
 - ❖ Skater whose solo or dance music is playing has right of way on the ice.
 - ❖ Skater whom is in a lesson with their Coach also has right of way on the ice.
 - ❖ Do not interrupt a Coach if he/she is with another skater
 - ❖ Chatting is off the ice – do not group together on ice as it interrupts flow
 - ❖ Please be nice and say a gentle "Excuse Me" if someone accidently is in your way
 - ❖ Remember your skate guards when off the ice
